

**CITY OF PARK RIVER, NORTH DAKOTA, RE-ORGANIZATIONAL COUNCIL MEETING,
TUESDAY, JUNE 26, 2018 AT 5:00 P.M.**

The re-organizational meeting of the Park River City Council met on Tuesday, June 26, 2018. Mayor Dan Stenvold called the meeting to order at 5:00 P.M. with the following present: Councilmen Mike Lorton, Joe Miller, Dennis Kubat, Keith Anderson, and by phone Robert “Bob” Lundquist III, City Attorney Tracy Laaveg, Public Works Director Dennis Larson, City Coordinator/Auditor Nancy Thompson, and Assessor/Deputy Auditor Ann Berg. Absent: Councilman Kyle Halvorson, Arvid Knutson, and Dwight Byron. Others present: Ashleigh Miller.

Thompson read the vote counts for each candidate as received from the Walsh County Auditor\ Kris Molde. Lundquist moved and Lorton seconded to accept the Canvas of Votes from the June 12, 2018 as received from the WC Auditor. Upon roll call, all voted aye. M/C.

The Oath of Office was read and the following were sworn in: Mayor Stenvold; Councilmen Joe Miller and Dennis Kubat; City Attorney Tracy Laaveg, Auditor Nancy Thompson, and Deputy Auditor Ann Berg.

Miller moved and Kubat seconded to nominate Bob Lundquist for Council President. Upon roll call vote, Lorton, Miller, Kubat, and Anderson voted aye with Lundquist abstaining. M/C.

Miller moved and Anderson seconded to nominate Kyle Halvorson for Council Vice President. Upon roll call vote, all voted aye. M/C.

Mayor Stenvold appointed Nancy Thompson as the Auditor, Ann Berg as the Deputy Auditor and Tracy Laaveg as the City Attorney. Lorton moved and Lundquist seconded to approve the appointments. Upon roll call vote all voted aye. M/C.

Council discussed bike path issues. Stenvold appointed a bike path committee to oversee repair and maintenance of the path and advise on the planting and maintenance of the trees, shrubs and flowers. Miller asked that a line item for the bike path be added to the budget.

PWD Larson reported to overlay the bike path would cost over \$60,000. Thompson reported there are two grants available with a 20% cost share. Estimates along with grant applications will need to be submitted this fall for the 2019 construction season. Lundquist felt the issue should be tabled until fall.

Being no further business, Lundquist moved to adjourn at 5:30 PM.
