

**CITY OF PARK RIVER, NORTH DAKOTA, STREET COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES,
WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 30, 2015 AT 5:00 P.M.**

The City of Park River held a Street Committee meeting on Wednesday, September 30, 2015 at 5:00 P.M. to discuss options for the alley on the north side of Hobbs St.

Street Committee Chair Dwight Byron called the meeting to order with the following present: Committee members Arvid Knutson, Bob Lundquist, Public Works Director Dennis Larson, City Attorney Tracy Laaveg, City Coordinator Jolene Halldorson, and City Auditor Ann Berg.

Halldorson reported she had received four options, from engineering firm KLJ, Inc., for the alley located north of Hobbs Street. After discussing the options with Laaveg and Larson, she is recommending option #1 which would leave the alley in place while making improvements to help with spring and rain runoff. Byron asked if millings could be used. Larson said the road would be shaped to help water drain to the south along the curb and gutter by Sandy Rostvet's then go across the road to the east side down to the park through the culvert and millings could be put on the alley road.

Lundquist moved and Knutson seconded to go with option #1 as recommended. Upon roll call vote, all voted aye. M/C.

Being no further business, Laaveg moved to adjourn the meeting at 5:16 PM.
