

Homme Dam and Lake are located on the South Branch of the Park River two miles west of the city of Park River, N.D., on Highway 17. Homme Dam was built primarily for flood control and water supply benefits. Construction began in 1948 and was completed in 1950.

At this beautiful 200-acre lake you can enjoy canoeing, water skiing, boating and fishing. The Walsh County Park Board operates a park near the dam that provides facilities for boat launching, camping and picnicking. The surrounding land, managed by the Corps of Engineers, is open to hiking, hunting, cross country skiing and snowmobiling.

Today, Homme Dam has been reconstructed and has a new "beach" swimming area near the dam itself.

A bike/walk path has been constructed from the west side of Park River to the Homme Dam Recreation Area.
